Places are limited and on a first come, first serve basis. It is not possible to pre-register before our in-person registration nights. Should classes become overbooked, priority will be given to Dorval residents. However, depending on demand and teacher availability, extra classes may be added.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

If you test positive for COVID-19, you must not come to class.

Masks: At this time, masks are not mandatory, but strongly encouraged if you have a cough, cold or covid symptoms (with negative test results).

Open studio time is no longer available to students. All work must be completed during class time only.

Refund policy:

Refund requests for cancellations of course must be submitted to DPG at least one week prior to the first class. An administration fee of \$20.00 will be withheld for processing.

Once the course has started, partial refunds are available only if a replacement student can be found. Refunds are issued pro-rata according to the number of classes attended, minus the \$20 administration fee.

For 6, 7 or 8 class courses, partial refunds are only available if a replacement student can be found before the 2nd class. For 10 class courses partial refunds are only available if a replacement student can be found before the 4th class.

It is not possible to make up, transfer or reimburse missed classes due to absence*.

*In case of missed classes due to grave illness or other extenuating circumstances, a partial credit may be issued at the discretion of the DPG.

In the event of a class cancellation due to teacher absence or extreme weather, a makeup class will be scheduled (generally in the form of an additional week added to the semester).

DPG reserves the right to cancel a class due to low registration. In this case, registrants will be fully reimbursed.
